MARYLAND DNR FOREST SERVICE STATE FIRE MANAGEMENT TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT

The Maryland DNR Forest Service Fire Management Staff is offering the NWCG certified training course **S-212: Wildland Fire Chain Saws**.

This is a four-day training, designed to provide wildland firefighters and other chain saw operators with a better understanding of how to safely and effectively operate a chain saw. Topics to be covered include: safety, maintenance, operation, bucking, limbing, felling, and using chain saws to build fireline. The training will be hands-on, with the first two days spent in the classroom, and the last two days in the field, operating the saws.

Dates: Saturday and Sunday, February 26th & 27th, 2011; **and**
Saturday and Sunday, March 5th & 6th, 2011.

Training will begin promptly at 0830 hrs, and end at 1700 hrs each day.
